When JOHAR project starts in 2014 I was very young to sit in meeting s but though I attend the meetings, after marriage in 2018 with my neighbor, my husband stopped me to do though I still continue attending the meetings, my understand level raises and I begin to learn and talk and conclude my words, I was fully involved so community members decided to add me as a core committee member. At home I feel respect by every family member. And after my journey starts I was trained on different govt. Schemes, which improved my self confidence and this is due to JOHAR project.
